

JMT Equipment List



Required Gear

- Helmet
- Harness
- Self locking belay device (ATC-Guide)
- 2 Cordelettes (7mm nylon cord, 17 feet long)
- Purcell Prusik (6mm nylon cord, 105 inches long)
- Prusik (6mm nylon cord, 40 inches long)
- 3 slings
- 5 locking carabiners – key lock gates are preferred
- 6 non-locking carabiners
- Climbing shoes
- Mountaineering boots – with toe welts to accept crampons (These may be rented)
- Ski or Snowboard boots
- Backcountry set-up – AT/telemark/splitboard with skins (These may be rented)
- Backpack (40-55 Liters)
- Approach/running shoes
- Headlamp
- Water bottle

Recommend Clothing

- Synthetic or wool long underwear top
- Heavy weight synthetic or wool long underwear bottom
- Medium to heavy weight synthetic or wool top
- Down or Prima-loft sweater or vest
- Gore-tex or similar waterproof and breathable wind shell top with hood
- Gore-tex or similar waterproof and breathable wind shell pants or bibs
- Schoeller pants
- Gore-tex or similar waterproof and breathable gloves
- Extra warm mittens
- Synthetic or wool hat that covers the ears and fits under a helmet
- Heavy synthetic or wool socks
- Boot gaiters if shell pants do not make a snug fit
- Light weight glove liners
- Balaclava to cover the face
